

Knowledge for College Info Sheet.

The University Guidance Program at Pestalozzi Education Centre supports, guides and assists students and parents to research universities, make choices, find scholarships, complete applications and enrol in the university.

Students in the K4C curriculum take ownership of the process by maintaining high academic achievement, participating fully in the life of the school and maintaining regular communication with their counselor.

Service learning is an integral aspect of the Pestalozzi Education Centre ethos.

Students enrolled in the Counseling curriculum should participate in at least 32 hours of Community service, be actively involved in at least one extracurricular activity and attend one summer program in a year.

It's important for students to find extracurricular activities that align with their academic and personal interests. Colleges and universities look for well-rounded students who have demonstrated a variety of interests and skills. Extracurricular activities can also help students stand out in the admissions process, and show that they are committed to other interests outside of academics.

The SAT (College Entrance exams) is a standardized test widely used for college admissions. It measures students' skills in reading, writing, and mathematics, and is designed to assess their readiness for college-level work.

Some Universities are SAT test optional, however, we encourage all IBDP and ECZ students in the last two years with intentions to apply to Universities around the world to sit for SAT exams and to take an English Test such as IELTS, TOEFL and Duolingo.
