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### About Enko Education

Enko Education, a fast-growing network of African international schools, is dedicated to providing students across the continent with access to the world's top universities. ### School and Community

Enko Maputo opened in January 2016. Our state-of-the-art campus is located in the upmarket Sommerschield neighborhood. The campus, which is comprised of secondary and primary wings, can house more than 300 students. The state-of-the-art secondary section offers 16 classrooms, spacious Science and ICT laboratories, a library, administration offices, a multi-purpose room, a canteen, and ample outdoor space. Our student population reflects the diversity of Maputo's middle class. Families from the capital, other parts of Mozambique, South Africa, and Europe choose Enko Maputo to ensure their children benefit from excellent educational programs. Many of our clientele parents work for international and, larger Mozambican companies, hold senior positions in the public or NGO sector, or run small to medium-sized, private businesses. Our students are mainly derived from private or public Portuguese-speaking Mozambican schools, English-speaking Cambridge schools, or schools offering the South African curriculum. Enko Maputo offers a flexible school fee payment plan to cater to individual parents who may encounter financial challenges. In 2018, Enko Maputo initiated an award-based scholarship for exceptional high-achieving learners. In 2019, about 55% of the students received need-based financial aid. Enko Maputo has occasionally engaged in initiatives for community development and assistance in times of crisis. In January 2023, our DP students-initiated #“together for Boane” aimed at assisting cyclone victims in and around Maputo. These efforts are ingrained in the school culture, mainly spearheaded by DP students in their CAS projects.

## Curriculum



Enko Maputo is authorized by the International Baccalaureate to offer the IB Diploma Program. The school is also authorized by Cambridge International Examinations to offer the Cambridge Lower Secondary and IGCSE Levels. Enko Maputo offers Foundation years (Cambridge Lower Secondary) in grades 8 and 9, which are assessed by external Cambridge Checkpoint Examinations. Successful students can then move into the Cambridge IGCSE in grades 10 and 11 and afterward progress to the International Baccalaureate Diploma Program in grades 12 and 13. The identification of grade levels corresponds to the local school systems. In terms of average ages, the students completing the IB Diploma Program would normally finish grade 12 in typical international schools.

## Grading procedures

Students at Enko Maputo are not ranked, and neither are their cumulative GPA. Grading is based on the International Baccalaureate (IB) grade system of 1-7 scale with 4 being the minimum passing grade. Theory of Knowledge and Extended Essay are part of the 2-year IB Diploma. Students take 6 courses and can earn up to 42 points. This is added to the possible 3 points for exemplary performance in TOK and Extended Essay. Thus, the total point score is 45. Enko Maputo Campus does not convert IB points to any other grading system. For Foundation Year, grading is from 1-8 which is the numeric equivalent of the IGCSE grading system of A\* - G. Subjects are broad-based to help them make good choices at IGCSE and DP level. For IGCSE, grading is based on the Cambridge International Examinations grade system of A\* - G. Students also have subjects with Core and Extended levels to choose from.



## Knowledge for College

The K4C (Knowledge for College) program, an exclusive initiative of Enko Education, is a comprehensive three-year curriculum commencing with the MYP (10th Grade). This program is designed to educate students about local and global higher education opportunities. It has been specifically developed to address local students' readiness gaps for higher education.

K4C is committed to empowering African youth to explore their purpose, pursue further education, and thrive in an ever-evolving world. Our approach guides students in developing essential skills in communication, self-management, and problem-solving, enabling them to research and evaluate their future opportunities effectively.

### Extracurricular activities



Enko Maputo Campus offers a variety of weekly activities as part of its Creativity, Activity, and Service (CAS) program. Students engage in diverse clubs and sports, including football, volleyball, basketball, Taekwondo, Rotary Club, chess, creative writing, science and art.
