Dear Parents and friends,

A decree from the MINESEC has recently been released, in which Enko Bonanjo International School has been included in the list of establishments that do not meet the necessary criteria for compliance with the Cameroonian law.

This decree does not reflect the latest steps Enko Education has undertaken to finalize the file for creation and opening of the school. The folder has been hand-delivered to the Regional Delegate of Coastal Secondary Educations on June 22.

We confirm that all of the required documents have been gathered. We built the file working closely with the Regional Delegate and his team, whom we thank for their support.

We are taking all necessary actions to restore the previous situation, within the shortest time, and we are actively working closely with the authorities to do so. The issue will quickly be resolved, and we assure you that the start of school 2017 will take place on the dates initially planned, entirely in accordance with current regulations.

We are fully confident about the fact that the establishment of Enko Bonanjo Internation School meets the expectations of the Ministry of Secondary Education, the parents and the students, like every other Enko school.

Please note that this matter has our full attention, and all Enko staff remains at your disposal.
