Foundation 1 field trip report

On November 23, 2017 Foundation 1A & 1B visited the Matola Raid Memorial Monument and the Interpretative centre. The primary interest of this visit was to learn more about the history of Apartheid and understand how far the Southern African countries, particularly Mozambique, were affected by the Apartheid regime of South Africa.

The idea of putting down books and pens and go to a new location with interesting things to see and experience was widely welcomed by students, so they were eager to get to the monument.

It was a worthwhile learning opportunity as students got engaged with the historic site, memorial and work of arts in person on the local what constituted a supplement to their school learning through an interesting real life experience. Furthermore, they made alive their lesson on Apartheid as they saw, touched and heard about the objects on the local. Students were so fascinated by the local and seemed to have had a great experience. According to some reports I received from them, they found the visit remarkably resourceful because the monument and the interpretative centre assembles all the Southern African history from the twentieth century until now.
