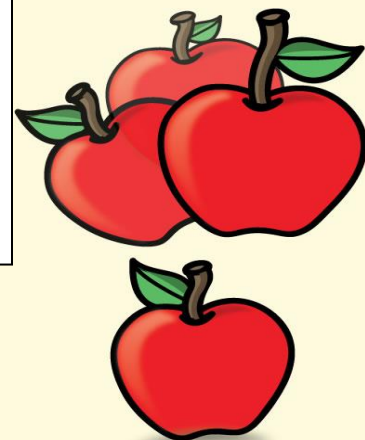

The railings are those long spaces separating the classes.



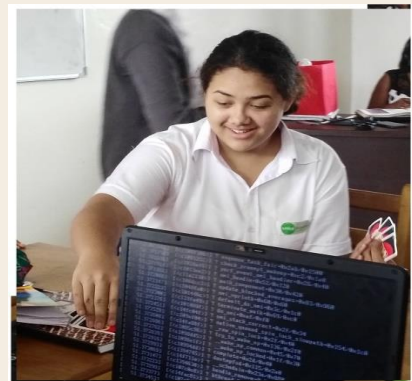
THE PLAYGROUND
