Enko Education is a network of African international schools, increasing access to high-quality international education across Africa. Today, our 3,000 learners are safely studying from home, and our 500 teachers and staff are also safe.

The Covid-19 Support Fund

Some African families are particularly affected by the Covid-19 crisis, and struggle to pay school fees.

Enko Education is creating the Covid-19 Support Fund, to allow for donors to financially support those families during the crisis, by paying school fees for them on a monthly basis.

The Enko Sponsorship Programme

It will be more than ever a challenge for children from disadvantaged backgrounds to access good quality education.

The Enko Sponsorship Programme aims at offering opportunities to the most disadvantaged children across the continent, through 1 to 3 years scholarships paid by sponsors.




The Covid-19 Support Fund

The current Covid-19 pandemic is affecting the whole African continent:

- Some of our parents are particularly affected financially and can't afford school fees anymore, because they have lost their jobs, or are suffering from a salary cut.
- Schools have closed, and Enko Education has implemented distance learning in all schools, require teachers to go the extra mile to quickly adapt to new teaching methods and not compromise on the quality of education we deliver
- Feedback from families has been been overwhelming, and we wish to maintain the quality of our online distance learning, by maintaining our teachers' salaries and motivation intact.

We are calling to our community to help our families affected by the crisis to pay for their school fees, so we can keep paying our teachers and delivering high-quality education to their children.

Eligibility criteria & allocation process

Funds are allocated upon three criteria:

- The family can prove they have been financially affected by the Covid-19 crisis
- The family has always paid school fees on time and has no history of default payment with the school
- The student has been assiduously following the online lessons offered by the school.

Applications are collected in the schools. A dedicated Committee at group level review applications and decides on funds allocation.

Funds are allocated on a monthly basis, and renewed upon proof that the financial situation hasn't changed and that the student is still assiduously following online lessons.

Enko Education Sponsorship Programme

Enko Education aims at increasing access to the world's best universities, by increasing access to high-quality international education for learners across Africa.

To allow the most underprivileged ambitious students to benefit from our high-quality international education and to higher education opportunities, Enko Education implements a ambitious sponsorship programme aiming at offering scholarships to students who could not afford an international education otherwise. Our intention is that at least 10% of our students in our 15 African international schools benefit from scholarships.

Our scholarships are merit and need based, and recipients are selected through a complete process aiming at evaluating their financial need and academic and behavioural merit.




Eligibility criteria & allocation process

- 1. Scholarships recipients are identified through partnerships with local disadvantaged schools and/or NGOS.
- 2. The selection process at school level includes:
 - An admission test
 - A review of past report cards
 - An interview with the Head of School to assess the child's potential and discuss his/her ambitions and dreams for the future
 - A thorough assessment of the family's financial situation is made. Objective is to identify brilliant children that could not afford Enko Education without funding.
- 3. The Enko Education Scholarships Committee then allocates the right amount of scholarships to the most promising candidates at group level.

Total cost of our High School Programme: USD 12,712 over three years

What Enko Education covers:

- · Scholarship students benefit from:
- a 100% discount on enrolment fees
- a 10% discount on tuition fees.
- Enko schools will locally raise external funds to cover for the uniforms, stationery, books, canteen, etc of the most disadvantaged: this can represent up to USD 1,900 per year.

Benefits for the donors

- · Have an annual call with the students they are sponsoring
- Will receive a termy report on how the students are performing academically and personally
- Will be able to require interviews from the students for their own communication during the time of their sponsorship
- Will be quoted in all future interviews of the sponsored student (for sponsors paying for all three years).


