

Dear Parents,

I hope that you and your families are keeping well. I am writing to inform you that the Checkpoint external assessment at Enko Bonanjo Campus has now been scheduled to take place from June 15 - June 17, 2020. The exams will be written between the hours of 8:00am-11:20am daily.

To ensure the wellbeing of our students during the written part of this exam, Enko Bonanjo has put in the following measures

- All students must come to school with a face Mask. Upon entering the school, any student without a face mask will be provided one. Face mask must remain on students faces until they exit the building

- At the gate, all students, staff or anyone assessing the building will have their temperature monitored using an Infrared Digital Forehead Thermometer

- All students and staff must wash their hands before having access to any of the classrooms used for the checkpoint exams.

- They will be a maximum of four students per class. Between one examination paper to the next, students will have a short break of 30 minutes, during which they are only allowed to use the restrooms in turns, revise for the next written paper. Teachers will have a responsibility to ensure students maintain social distancing guidelines

- On daily basis, they will be routine cleaning and disinfecting of the classrooms and all working surfaces that the students will come in contact with

Allowing your child to return to school is parental choice and I will be asking you what your intentions are to help us with our planning.
