## <u>Subject :</u> CAS Camp – Foumban 2023

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Following the <u>school calendar</u> shared with you at the beginning of the year, we are pleased to announce that the **annual \*CAS Camp for the students has been scheduled to take place from Monday, January 30th to Thursday, February 02, 2023 (Four Days) at** Foumban, Cameroon.

The CAS Camp encourages students to be involved in diverse creative activities, community and service experiences, thereby promoting students' awareness and appreciation for life outside the classroom.

This CAS Camp is also an ideal way to impact Cambridge and IB values and practices in students, helping them to identify their own strengths and develop areas for personal growth. It is also a platform where students get to effectively collaborate amongst themselves and the community.

The planned activities for this CAS Camp include:

- Visit of the "Bamoun" Kings Museum
- Visit of the handicraft village and manufacture of art objects and production of Bronze
- Morning fitness routines, games, and awards
- A guided tour of the Royal Palace and exchange with the sultan
- Workshop with students at "Institut des Beaux Arts de Foumban"
- Clean-up day supervised by the urban council
- CAS Campfire night, involving cultural dances and sharing of experiences
- Upon their return, students when they returned are expected to present in groups a reflective report on their CAS camp journey.

As the trip date approaches, an information session with parents will be organized; details of the trip and a checklist of required and optional items needed will be discussed.



## <u>Cost of the Trip</u>

The cost of the trip is 100000 FRS (One hundred thousand francs) CFA per student, as mentioned on the <u>school fees sheet</u>, payable on or before the 20th of December 2022. Payment can be made at the bank or via cheque (Cf. <u>fees sheet</u>).

<u>Reminder:</u>

The CAS Camp is **MANDATORY** for all students. Students will be accompanied by the entire staff and tourist guides in Foumban. Both students and staff traveling will be insured.
