# IB DP Curriculum Model

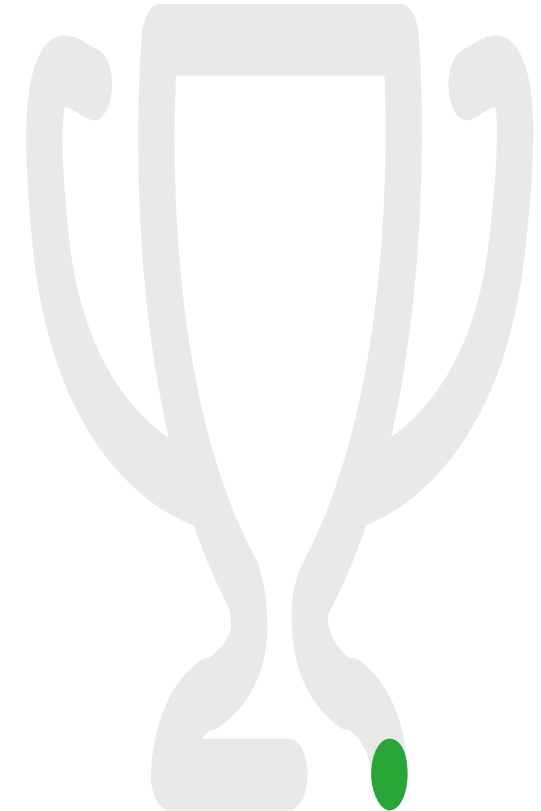


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The IB Diploma is the most prestigious and most recognized diploma to get admitted into top universities from across the world. It is a perfect transition for students into universities.

# IB Diploma Programme - Assessment

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Assessment at end of the course:

- **Written, oral, coursework** which give students opportunities to demonstrate learning.
- There are options for students with different abilities (**SL** and **HL**). Students must take 3 SL and 3 HL
- Grades range from **1-7**, with **7** being the highest.

# How IB DP Examinations are managed

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- IB DP Examination is set and sent to the school by the IB Examination Board.
- The exams are conducted at ENKO BONANJO between April/May for the May Session.
- The answer scripts are sent to the IB Board for marking/grading.
- Results are released on July 8th

# What will happen

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- Mock exams started this morning and will run till **March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2023**. The exam timetable has been shared with students as well as parents.
- An intensive revision program across the network will run from March 13<sup>th</sup> to April 21<sup>st</sup>. Students are expected to be in school everyday till April 21<sup>st</sup>.
- The IB DP exam will run from April 28<sup>th</sup> to May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2023.

## What you can do to help your child...

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- Make sure they are well rested. Encourage them at all time.
- Make sure they eat a light, but healthy breakfast!
- Make sure they get to school on time (7:45am at the latest)
- Make sure they bring their own equipment: 2 blue pens; 2 pencils; an eraser; a ruler; a pair of compasses; a calculator; a protractor; a simple translating dictionary; a transparent bottle of water

# Responsibility of the school

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- Guided revisions sessions with Past Examination papers
- Extended sessions, to permit student have enough time to study
- Mock exams to assess students' level and come up with individualized action plans for students with difficulties
- In-school study retreat during Easter break.

# What happens with the results

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- Results will reach the school on the 9<sup>th</sup> of July
- Results will be shared with individual students, individual parents and staff
- Each student will have a statement of achievement and then a certificate
- The school will share the results with the wider school community

# IB DP Point Scale



- IB DP is graded **1-7**
- IB DP results in individual subjects are indicated by the grades **1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7** or **N**. Grade **7** is awarded to those students showing **highest ability** in a subject and grade **1** for a **minimum satisfactory** performance.
- If a component of a subject be it IA or written exam is not submitted, the candidate gets an **N**.
- If a student gets a disqualifying grade in a **CORE**, he/she receives a certificate & **NOT** a Diploma

# What is required to be awarded the IB Diploma

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- Students will need to have at least a **24/45** including a qualifying grade for the **CORE** to be awarded the IB Diploma
