# School and Community

Enko Keur Gorgui is a selective secular and co-ed school, which opened its doors in 2017 in Dakar, Senegal with the ambition to offer its students a bilingual education with an international perspective. Enko Keur Gorgui is the first International Baccalaureate candidate school offering the MYP in Senegal. Its objective is to prepare students for social and professional success, opening the door to opportunities to study at internationally-recognized institutions of higher education and to provide students with the means to become responsible global citizens by learning individual responsibility and collective action. Our learners are mostly Senegalese from middle-class families with the ambition to study in the world's best universities. Learners learn to grow African roots and global wings, by learning about their African cultures while being exposed to travel opportunities through study tours and conferences.

Enko Keur Gorgui has highly-qualified personnel: all of our staff receive up to 100 hours of professional development per year.

### Curriculum

The institution is accredited by the Senegalese Ministry of Education and the International Baccalaureate Organization in Geneva. It was authorized to deliver the IB Diploma Programme for Grade 12 & 13 since September 2018 and Middle-Years Program for Grade 7 to 11 in December 2019.

### IBDP subjects offered to the Class of 2021:

French, English, History Economics, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Computer Science, Mathematics AA, Mathematics AI and Visual Arts

All subjects are offered as SL and HL.

# **Grading equivalencies**

### Average class size - 25

Students at Enko Keur Gorgui Campus are neither ranked nor do they have a cumulative GPA. In the last two years of high school, grading is based on the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) grade system of 1-7 scale with 3 being the minimum passing grade. Theory of Knowledge and Extended Essay are part of the 2-year IB Diploma. Students take 6 courses and can earn up to 42 points. This is added to the possible 3 points for exemplary performance in the TOK course and the Extended Essay. Thus, the total point score is 45. Enko Keur Gorgui Campus does not convert IB points to any other grading system.

For IB Middle Years Program (IB MYP) offered grade 7 to grade 11 (MYP1 to MYP5), grading is based on the IBMYP grade system of 1-8 in each criterion which is translated into the 1 to 7 point scale.

### **Extracurricular Activities**

All students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities. However, there are few clubs that are offered through the school. This being said, there are sports teams such as soccer and basketball that are available to students. All IB students are required to complete the IB CAS (Creativity Action Service) requirement in order to graduate. This includes individual projects and group activities approved by the IB and CAS Coordinators.
