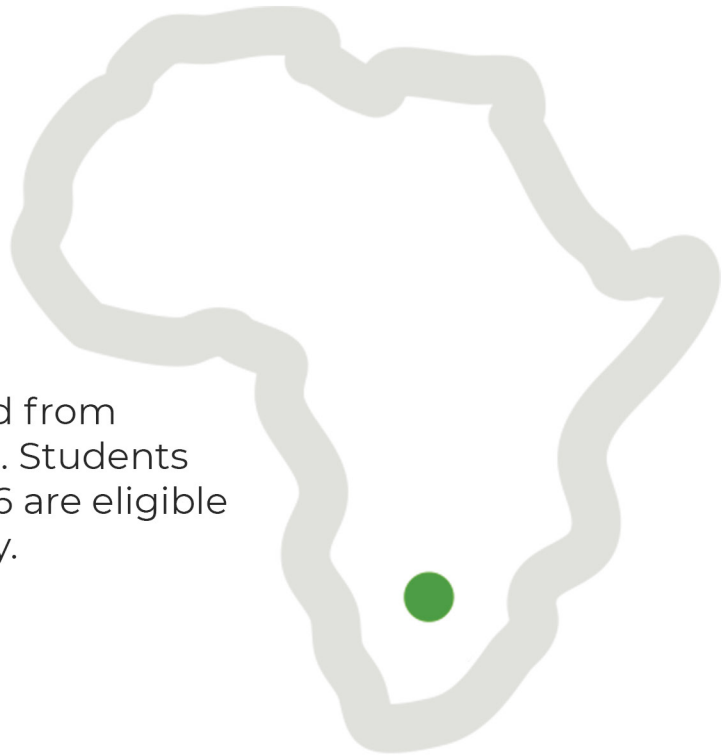

Cambridge International School

Enko Botho follows the Cambridge curriculum at Primary Level. Making the transition into Secondary form 1 seamless.

The student teacher ratio at Enko Botho is 24 students per class.

Children are taught and have opportunities to learn in a range of ways – individually, in groups and as a whole class, as appropriate. At all stages, children learn, practise and refine a wide range of skills in all their activities across the Cambridge Curriculum. These are described as key skills as they help learners to improve their learning throughout their education, as well as in later life.

We offer creative arts including art, music and drama. The school also has a pool for swimming, sporting courts and ICT labs for tech and innovation classes. As well as an array of other activities to keep students active and engaged outside the classroom.

Mandatory Documents and fees to submit when applying

1. Application fee P300
2. Copy of student's birth certificate
3. Copy of parents IDs or passports
4. 2 passport size photos
5. Reports from previous school (for transferring students, standard 1 to standard 6)
6. Fees clearance certificate from previous school

Parents can apply for a Reception place any time after their child's fourth birthday. Prospective parents will need to contact the school office for the appropriate Reception application form which needs to be completed and returned together with the child's birth certificate, proof of address and photo identification of both parents, if possible.
