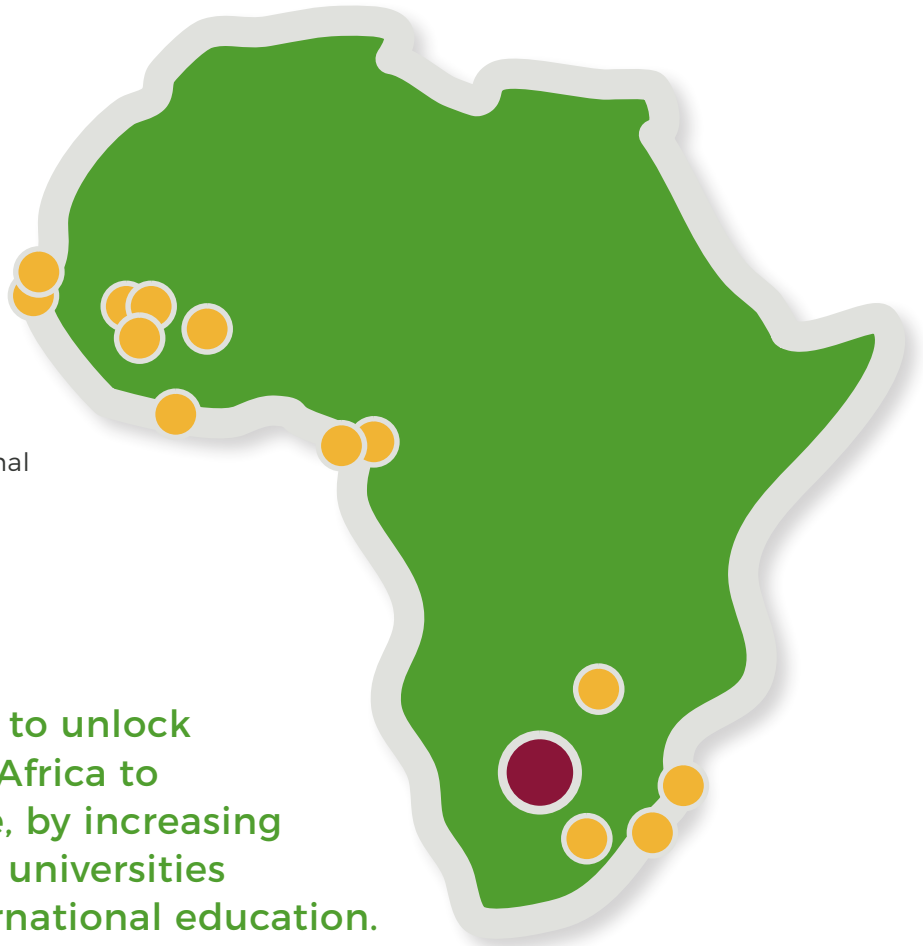
About Enko Botho

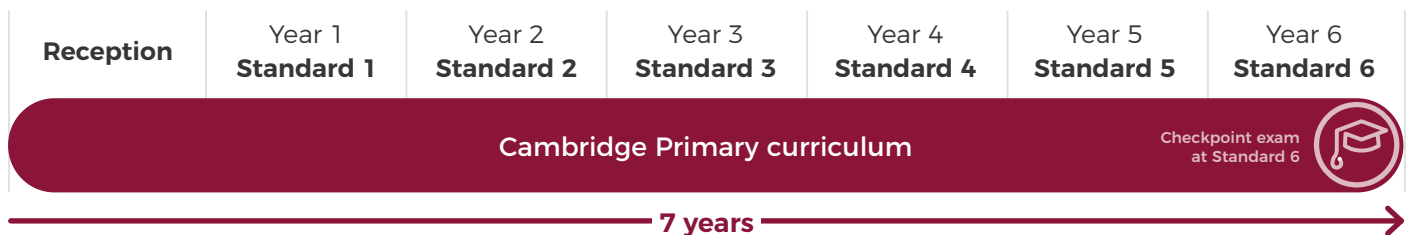
World-renowned international curricula

Enko Botho follows the Cambridge curriculum at Primary Level. Making the transition into Secondary Form I seamless.

At all stages, children learn, practise and refine a wide range of skills in all their activities across the Cambridge Curriculum.

These are described as key skills as they help learners to improve their learning throughout their education, as well as in later life.



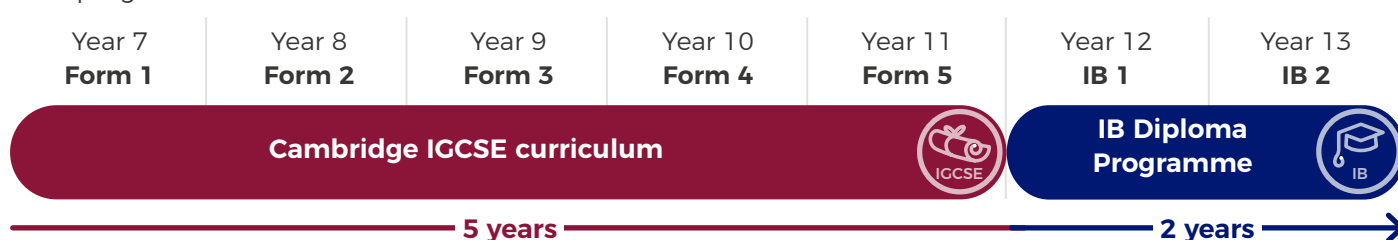
The student teacher ratio at Enko Botho is 24 students per class. Children are taught and have opportunities to learn in a range of ways - individually, in groups and as a whole class, as appropriate.



Our curricula

World-renowned international curricula Secondary

Enko Botho combines two of the world's most prestigious curricula in a 7-year programme, namely Cambridge Assessment International Examination in Form 1 through Form 5 (IGCSE), and the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP) in IB1 and IB2 . In just 5 years students obtain their IGCSE and are then encouraged to pursue their studies with the IBDP, with an option to also pursue the AS/A-level programme.



The **Cambridge IGCSE** is the world's most popular international qualification for 14-16 year olds. It is recognised by leading universities and employers worldwide and is an international passport to progression and success.

The curriculum offers a variety of routes for learners with a wide range of abilities, including those whose first language is not English. Throughout the IGCSE programme the learner will be evaluated through written, oral, coursework and practical assessment, and they are tested at the end of the course.

Cambridge International A Level is typically a two-year course, and Cambridge International AS Level is typically one year. Some subjects can be started as a Cambridge International AS Level and extended to a Cambridge International A Level.



The **International Baccalaureate (IB)** is for 16-19-year-olds; there are over 5,000 IB schools in 150 countries. The IB is recognised by universities for the holistic and rigorous education it provides.

Combined, these programmes, prepare students to excel in over 10,000 universities worldwide.



Mandatory Documents and fees to submit when applying (These should be attached to the online application)

1. Application fee P300
2. Copy of student's birth certificate
3. Copy of parents IDs or passports
4. Two passport size photos
5. Reports from previous school (for transferring students, standard I to Form 4)
6. Fees clearance certificate from previous school standard



Parents can apply for a Reception place any time after their child's fourth birthday. Prospective parents will need to contact the school office for the appropriate Reception application form which needs to be completed and returned together with the child's birth certificate, proof of address and photo identification of both parents, if possible.
