School Requirements

Transportation

Bus routes are available and continually reviewed to accommodate for new locations depending on the homes of students. Routes begin in town and reach all areas of Lusaka

School Rules

Girls' Hair: Girls are permitted to braid their hair using black cotton or braids only and must be tied always. We do not allow weaves or extensions. kindergarten no beads

Illness/Absenteeism: Parents/Guardians should call when students are sick and bring a medical note upon return to school. 10 days absent will equal an automatic suspension from school.

Uniforms: The school uniform must be worn in full each day of the week, unless a notice has gone home notifying parents/guardians of a special event. The sports kit must only be worn on days where physical education is scheduled in the timetable.
